#### - ELECTION SPECIAL -

For the first two years the powers of the Congress has been vested in a Board of Directors, as well it should be, however, each director was appointed and voted-in by the Board of Directors.

Unbiased? Impartial? Gerrymandering is a better word for it? But whatever it is called, don't knock it. It has worked for the good of the Congress. A darn good job has been done, is being done and will be done. The workings of this administration will continue to unfold between here & yonder horizen. A bright horizen, that is.

Anyway, now we get to elect our Directors.. Election day is July 1, 1981 with the newly elected officials taking office effective September 1, 1981. Ballots will be mailed out at least 30 days prior to the official election date which should be sufficient time to look over the list of nominees, mark your X's and get it back in the mail.

How many are going to be elected? That is a good question and the answer is = twenty-five (25). The first twelve with the most votes will be in office for two years & the next thirteen will be elected for a one year term. After this we will elect 12 or 13 each year. You may vote for as many as you wish, but not morethan 25, and you are allowed to vote only once. Second ballots will be thrown out, so please do not try to stuff the ballot box....

The following special nominating rules must be observed:

- 1) No more than five may be nominated from any one state. (After this ruling was made it was discovered that six members were nominated from Wisconsin).
- 2) Nominations close: April 1, 1981
- 3) Make sure those you nominate have a desire to serve.
- 4) Nominations coming in from the field will be signed by at least five members.

The nominating committee did not contact anyone on the list to find out if they are willing to serve. So if there are any who have been nominated and do not wish or who are not able to serve, please contact the Secretary who is in charge of preparing the ballot...
