- GRAND NATIONAL STATISTICS -

The Grand National Championship conducted in Milwaukee last month cleared a slight profit of \$443.19....

The main event income was \$5568.00, minus the actual cash payback of \$5220.00 comes out to a cool 92 percent payback. However, when you add the cash value of donations for beer and championship trophies from the Pabst Brewing Company, it brings up the pay-back percentage to 104 - a five (*****) star tournament.....

The awards expense for 19 plaques, 34 framed certificates, 96 All American patches for two years and for a few ribbons totaled \$1216.41. This figure was not included in any of the stats on page 1. The awards program would have cost the Congress that much whether we had an awards banquet or not....

- MASTER POINT PARADE -

Here are the master point standings after the first three events of cribbage year 1982-83. The first fifteen players earned their points at the Congress' Grand National in Milwaukee last month. The other two tournaments were the Washington State Championship, operated by Joe Nelson of Pineville, Oregon, and the Riverfest in Wilmington, NC, directed by Bill and Beth Carder where the pay-back was over 100% for the third straight year, (****).

Jim Pershing, our current leader, was a walk-on in Milwaukee and he joined the Congress sometime Saturday morning during the qualifying rounds. It's a ditto for Pat Flannick, the guy in third place. Of course, everyone in Cribbage World knows dear Doris Donalies who has been with us since the beginning... Doris was long overdue for her high finish in the Grand National Championship. Her great start just about assures her of a berth on the All American Ladies team (1983) for the third straight year.

AND, would you believe, that is the past MP champion way down there in 46th place with only 30 points after playing in two events? No sweat, says Arnie-boy, "Patrin and Riherd are not even on the board."

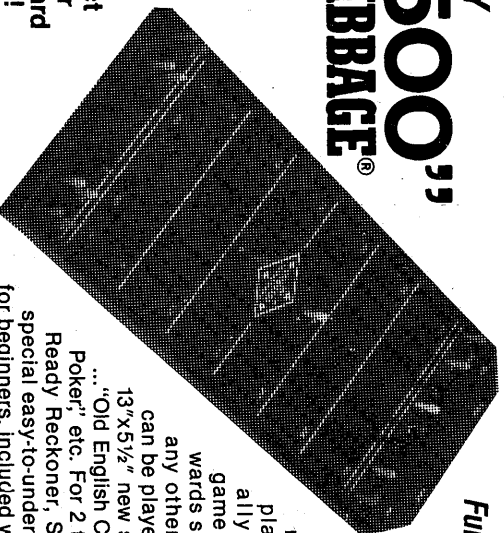
