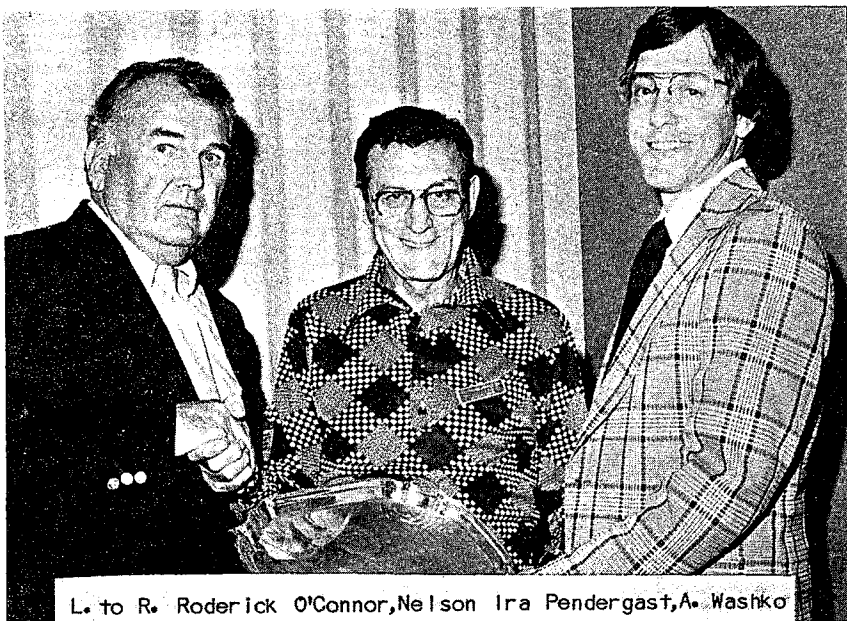

DEEP FREEZE CAN'T COOL CRIBBAGE CONTENDERS

Despite remarkably cold weather loyal cribbage enthusiasts continued their activities in hot competition in leagues and tournaments across the country. Each event brings new members to the Congress and we are grateful to the tournament directors as well as the recruiters who are spreading the news of the American Cribbage Congress.

The leading recruiters to date are headed by our diligent President Joe Wergin of Madison who continues to find new players in Wisconsin, enlisting 84 new members through his "GRASS ROOTS" program. Edward "Ned" O'Brien of South Burlington, VT, who has single-handedly put Vermont in the top ten states with recruitment of 72 new members is followed by Jim Arblaster of Kissamsee who has directed his energies to recruitment since stepping down from the secretary's post and has successfully brought 34 Floridians into membership in the Congress. Rhode Island's membership has increased by the efforts of Al Dinwoodie who has signed up 31 new peggers. Keep those new memberships coming, the Guy Pence Award awaits the top recruiter.

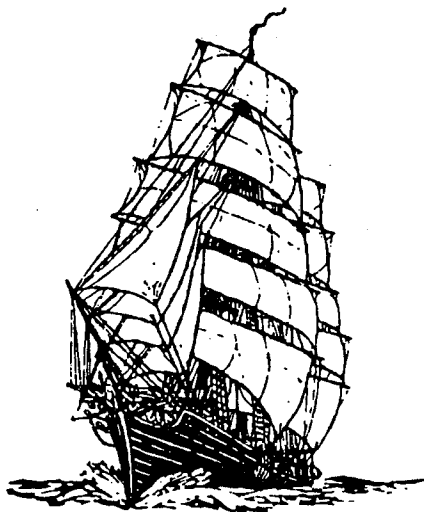

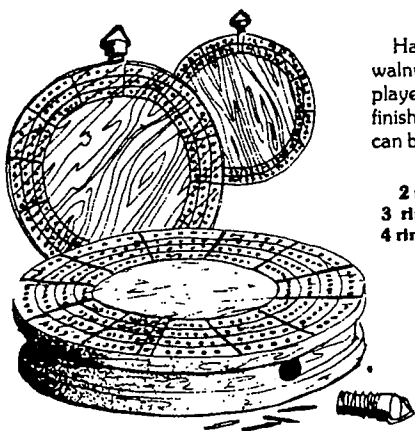
