

CLUB MEMBERS MAY RECEIVE A NATIONAL RATING

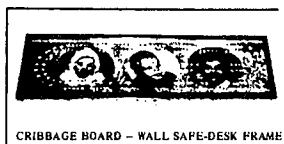
At the Illinois State Tournament August 28th, President Joe Wergin announced that plans are being completed for competition this winter between players of organized clubs which play once a week or twice a month.
