TOURNAMENT COMMISSIONER

Due to the increased number of sanctioned tournaments now being held thruout the country, and in order to provide better service to directors and participants in these tournaments; the position of Tournament Commissioner was created by the Board of Directors at their meeting in Raleigh. The responsibility of the Tournament Commissioner will be to co-ordinate and oversee the scheduling, sanctioning and reporting of all tournaments approved by the American Cribbage Congress.

The new Commissioner appointed by the Board is Jim Fabian, 77 Bunting Lane, Naperville, IL 60565. His telephone number is (312) 357-3166. Jim will be contacting all past tournament directors. All inquiries relating to tournament dates must be directed to him.

Tournament directors will be receiving several forms which must be filled out and returned to Jim before sanctioning will be granted. These procedures must be honored in order for tournaments to be announced and reported in the CW and in order for master points to be awarded on completion of a tournament.

We congratulate Jim on his appointment and welcome his effort to make future American Cribbage Congress sanctioned tournaments serve the membership better and increase the pleasure and comraderie of the game.

MASTER POINTS

The top 100 rated players for the 1984-85 season are all from the top 50 of each region of the country. Therefore we are not listing the top 100 separately. The cutoff for eligibility in the top 100 is 186 master points. Of the top 100, 37 people are from the Western region, 20 are from the Eastern region and 43 are from the Midwest region.

All tournaments have been reported except for The Marysville Tournament held on Nov. 3, 1984 and the Reno Bonanza Classic held in Sparks, NV on April 13, 1985. Mr. Charles Watters from Uba City, CA has not filed a report nor paid a sanctioning fee for these tournaments and therefore the right to master points have been forfeited. Mr. Watters will be denied any future sanctioning.

The 4th Annual River City Cribbage Tournament will be held on November 9th X 10th, 1985, at the Ramada Inn, in La Crosse, Wisconsin. The tournament is open to anyone 18 years and older. Entries will be limited to the first 250 received.

The tournament will begin promptly at 8 A.M. on Saturday. There will be a 30 minute orientation meeting with play beginning promptly at 8:45 A.M. All players will play 22 games on Saturday. The top 32/64 qualifiers will play in a single elimination match, best of 5 games, on Sunday. There will be a special "Consolation" tournament on Sunday for those players not qualifying on Saturday.

The entry fee is \$36.00 which includes sanction fees and lunch on Saturday. Any entry received without the entry fee will be returned. All entries must be sent on the form attached below or a photocopy of that form. All entries must be received by November 8, 1985. To eliminate having to play a spouse or a friend, entry forms must be received in the same envelope. Late entries cannot be guaranteed not playing a spouse or friend.

# MINNESOTA OPEN JULY 13-14, 1985 MINNEAPOLIS, MN

Directors John Williams and Scott Kooistra report that 158 players were present for this Fifth Annual Minnesota Open. Many newcomers to tournament play paticipated and two of them grabbed the top spots. Robert Sommer of Excelsior, MN was the champion as he defeated Steve Swanson of Brooklyn Park, MN. Mike Mueller of Crystal, MN took third and Gordon Gray from Minnetonka, MN finished fourth.

Larry Loupee of Newton, IA beat out director John Williams of Minneapolis in the consolation final, which attracted 86 players. Bob Gilbert of Ankeny, IA battled for third place over Frank Trojan of Shoreview, MN.

Saturday morning provided excitement as Gary Postel of Crystal, MN drew a 29 hand. Gary was certainly thrilled at that rare occurence. In the Saturday Night Special tournament, Al Olzenak of St. Paul, MN also got a 29 hand. 28 hands were received by Larry Loupee and George Ceminsky of Burnsville, MN.

# NATIONAL OPEN JULY 27-28-29, 1985 RALEIGH, NC

The annual Board of Directors meeting was held at the North Raleigh Hilton, the site of this years National Open. The second highest number of entries, 333, were recorded at this 12th annual event. Director Nick Pond reports that much good cribbage was played on the way to the championship which was won by Richard Wurman of Melrose Park, PA. Second place honors were awarded to Gary Roschewski of Fayetteville, NC. Walter Wasielewski from Jackson, MI took third over Dan Barlow, a former champion from Chapel Hill, NC.

The top prize in the consolation event was captured by Dick Cossack of St. Paul, MN over Jeff Shimp from Allegan, MI. Third place was taken by Betty Ward from Menominee Falls, WI. She was victorious over R.G. Sherfinski of Southport, NC who took 4th place.

The only 28 hand that was reported was held by Carol Jablonski from Fayetteville, NC.

We received a letter and a phone call from Henry Douglass of Reidsville, NC, praising this tournament as the best tournament ever held. Henry tells us that he had a lot of practice being a good loser playing 39 games and winning only 8.

The only unpleasantness he expierienced in an otherwise very enjoyable three days was the theft of his personalized North Carolina license plate inscribed with the word "CRIBBAGE". "I would have gladly given this plate, upon expiration, probably to the first person who asked for it", said Henry. But to the "so and so" who stole it, I hope you have shown it to many people and now they will know how you got it. You don't belong among honorable cribbage players.
