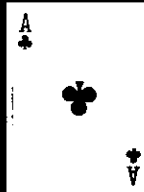

AMERICAN CRIBBAGE CONGRESS

Fiorini Tops Yankee Classic

Tom Fiorini, pegging out of West Springfield, MA, zipped to the championship at the recent Yankee Classic played at Rockville, CT. With a strong field of 116 peggers, Fiorini carted home 147 MRP's...and bragging rights. His final playoff match pitted him vs. Carl Deyette (CT) and he prevailed for the win. Life Master Sharlene Medeiros (MA) came home in the 3-4 bracket, and the 70 MRP's will keep her among the leaders in the Eastern Region. Dan Acari also finished in the 3-4 bracket (he is a non-member...but this high finish may boost his interest in the ACC).

Keith Widener (NC) topped the field in the qualifying round, scoring an excellent 22 11/12 +115 (and 45 MRP's).

In the 56-player Consolation, Barbara Barbour (CT) came home the winner. Barbour was last year's New England Long Match champ...and she continues her winning ways. Newly-crowned Life Master Donna LaFleur (CT) finished 2nd, followed by Bill Richmond (CT) and Louis Gentile (CT) in the 3-4 slot. Newly-crowned Two-Star Harry Palmer (MA) was the Q winner (16 6 +177), and he continues to be among the top in the Eastern Region.

Director Phil Martin reported that Palmer and George Webb scored those elusive 28-hands...but no 29's showed.

McGibney Wins Bah Humbug II

ACC Treasurer Fred McGibney, S. Burlington, VT came to play at the Bah Humbug II. This Master pegger bested some 94 peggers, played in Medway, MA on December 1. McGibney netted 147 MRP's, in addition to the winner's purse and another feather in his cribbage hat. Louis Mantee (ME) very nearly ran the table, qualifying tops (21 GP's, 12 games) and finishing 2nd, netting an aggregate 145 MRP's. Master Warren Gallagher (MA) and Master Barry Spadea (RI) nailed down 3-4.

Life Master Henry DeLong (MA) took home the 46-player Consolation win, followed by last year's "Rookie of the Year" David Campbell (ME) in 2nd. Campbell posted an outstanding 1,122 MRP's in his first full year of sanctioned pegging. Stan Plachowicz (MA) and Life Master David Clemmey (MA) finished 3-4. Master Ann Somers (MA) scored a 14 GP card (8 games) to take Q honors.

In an oddity, Grand Master Frank Corrado (CT) was the meet's top non-qualifier in the Main Event...and did the trick once again in the Consolation. One-Star Paul Hatcher (OR) also pulled this off last year in an Oregon match.

Director Sharlene Medeiros had a unique "Play to Lose" event, won by David Campbell. She also reported Shawn Jordan and Pat Martin scored 28-hands.

Toll, Colvert Win on December 8, Take MRP lead

Two veteran ACC peggers posted identical results on December 8. One-Star Duane Toll (WI) was tearing up the track at the Eau Claire Classic (WI), and two hours later on the Oregon coast Three-Star DeLynn Colvert (MT) was winding down a win at the Chinook Winds Open, boosting both players into the MRP lead in a virtual dead-heat, sharing it with the streaking Master Cres Fernandez (CA). Details below:

138 in Eau Claire Toll Steals Show In Wisconsin

It was the Duane Toll show at the recent 138-pegger Eau Claire Classic. He began a weekend he will long remember by taking 4th in the Friday kick-off event (\$890), and continued on the entire weekend, cashing in every event. He posted a 31 GP card on Saturday and continued on to take the playoffs as well, netting some 221 MRP's. He has topped 700 as this cribbage year hits the half-way mark. Grand Master Larry Loupee (IA) was the last victim of Toll's run, but he nevertheless carted home 147 MRP's along with 2nd money to ease his pain. Scott Fritz (WI) and Grand Master Bill Sperry (MN) finished 3-4...and added 105 MRP's to their ledger. Jerry Newhouse took the Q prize with a nice 35 16/22 +132.

Dennis Ulberg (WI) qualified tops (19 8/9 +146) in the 104-player Consolation, and came home 3rd in the playoffs to take home an aggregate 64 MRP's, but it was Master Pete Kufahl (WI) taking home the top prize in the playoffs. He nipped Master Clay Collier (NE) in the final playoff match. Master Tony Danihel (WI) finished in the 3-4 bracket with Ulberg.

Co-director Vickie Lindner had home-made pastries and banana-nut bread until noon every day. In addition, some 100 pounds of Wisconsin cheeses (all varieties) combined with 30 pounds of salami and beef summer sausage were dished out to keep alive the tradition of this match. And to top this off, large baskets of cheese, butter, fruit, wine and goodies were given to top non-qualifiers (Deb Kvien, Main; Nicky Kniech, Consolation), in addition to other baskets given away at satellite events. Lindner asks players to mark their calendars for a rematch the first weekend in December, 2003.

Record Crowd at Chinook Winds Open

The Chinook Winds Casino, located on the Pacific Ocean, always attracts a large crowd, and the recent December Open drew a record 221 peggers. Three-Star DeLynn Colvert (MT), on a roll recently, came home the winner, carting home an aggregate 251 MRP's (after qualifying 2nd with a 37 GP card). Master Don Brown (CA) finished 2nd, and the 147 MRP's have him but a stone's throw out of the national MRP lead (600+). Bill McCuen (OR) and Jeff Morrow (OR) finished 3-4...and earned 105 MRP's each. Grand Master Bruce Wridge (OR) tattooed the boards in the qualifying round, and posted a great 40 18/22 +205 to easily take honors.

Some 150 players stayed for the Consolation, and it was Mike Ritthaler (OR) winning going away. He bested Dan Marsh (OR) in the final playoff match. Cindy Lawrence (OR) and Mike Pendras (WA) came home 3-4. Vonita Gill (WA) posted a grand slam 18 9/9 +129 to easily take the Q prize.

This event is ably directed by Rollie Heath, Jeanne and Roy Hofbauer, and Bernie Nelson. They hosted the usual satellites, some with extra "Q" prizes. The winners:

A highlight saw Monica Newton (OR) score the ACC's 9th 29-hand this cribbage season...netting a nifty \$100 bonus from the ACC.

The host Chinook Winds has quality playing areas, and this time around the huge bingo parlor was used for play. A record 48 boards in a row made for an unusual setting. The casino furnished coffee, cakes, and soda for three days running. A rumor has it that co-director Rollie Heath may apply for the Grand National at this site in the year 2005.

Chambers, Hendricks Smoking In Canada

Grand Master John Chambers (RI), making a rare appearance in the Western Region, found it easy pickings as he zipped to the win at the recent Edmonton Open (Alberta, Canada). With 62 peggers in action, Chambers took home 105 MRP's, and can lay claim to being one of a handful of ACC peggers to take a Main Event in Canada. In addition to the Main Event win, he took home the High Roller, a member of the winning team...and some \$1,755 (Canadian).

Master Rosemary Hendricks (WA) owns a convenience store in Rochester, WA (off I-5) and she sneaks away for some pegging on a regular basis...and this time it paid off handsomely. She qualified tops (34 17/22 +196) and came home 2nd (110 MRP's). She paid for the trip, winning \$770 (Canadian). Local Doris Sanders and Joan Anderson finished 3-4.

Director Harold Buckley and spouse Marion took charge of the 42-player Consolation, with Harold taking first, and Marion second. Local Ron Saik qualified tops (19 8/9 +183) and zipped to a 3-4 finish with Rude Heidemann.

Emilio Perez, a Master pegger from Waukegan, IL, is still at it. He owns the ACC record score for a 22-game qualifying round (45 19/22 +477), and this time around he nailed down the championship at the recent Jesse James Open, played in Northfield, MN (Nov. 22-24). With a record 130 players in the field, Perez carted home 196 MRP's...and more bragging rights. His last playoff victim was Diane Waite (MN) and her 2nd-place finish rewarded her with a nifty 147 MRP's to ease the pain. Master Don Patrin (MN) and Sharon Schaefer (WI) took home 3-4...and 105 MRP's each.

Perez's record score inspired Master Al Lindner (WI) as he won 13 games in a row (3-15), and finished as the high qualifier with a 35 17/22 +100. Perez's record is still there, thank you!

Grand Master Jerry Fischer (WI) was rolling in the 72-player Consolation. He took top Q (18 8/9 +123) and finished 2nd in the playoffs to cart home an aggregate 81 MRP's. Del Anderst (MN) finished tops in the playoffs (84 MRP's). Newly crowned Life Master Don Flesch (WI) and Grand Master Robert Sommer (MN) finished 3-4 (40 MRP's each).

With 94 peggers in the field, it was Master Tony Montooth winning the recent Reynolds Christmas Wrap, played at Antioch, CA on November 24. His final playoff match pitted him vs. the formidable Master Roberta Nelson (CA); and his cards remained hot for the win. Master Don Brown (CA) is on a roll recently and he nailed down a 3-4 finish with Rod Marshall (WA). Both players took home 70 MRP's, keeping Brown among the nation's leaders. Marshall tatooed the boards all weekend, copping the All Events, aided by a Saturday night win.

John Holseth (OR) was burning up the track Friday night and Saturday morning. He zipped to the Early Bird win on Friday, and continued his hot streak in the qualifying round the next day. He took honors with a 36 16/22 +240.

52 peggers stayed for the Consolation, and Three-Star DeLynn Colvert (MT) came home the winner, besting Ben Holder (CA) in the final playoff match. Grand Master Heidi Glashan (CA) and Adrian Levy (CA) finished 3-4. Glashan was also the top Q winner with a 17 8/9 +152.

With the cribbage year at the half-way mark, three veteran peggers are setting the pace. Master Cres Fernandez (CA) has been tatooing the boards with regularity, winning the Winnemucca Fall Classic, and has posted 720 MRP's. One-Star Duane Toll (WI) and Three-Star DeLynn Colvert (MT) both posted wins in large events in early December and both peggers zip to 700+.

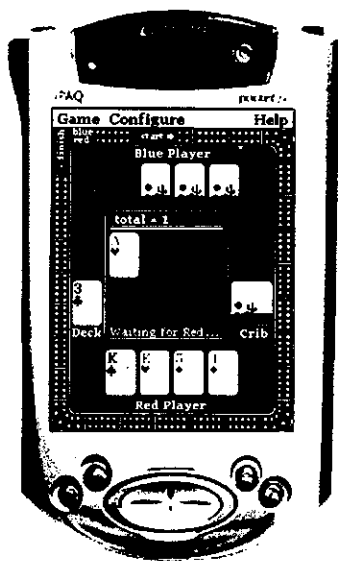

Keith Widener, pegging out of Clemmons, NC is on a roll this cribbage year. He recently came home the winner at the Hampton Roads November Shootout in Virginia Beach, VA...and he zips to the top of the Eastern Region leaderboard, and is among the leaders nationwide. This shootout hosted 60 peggers, and with the win, Widener brought yet another 105 MRP's and has topped 600 this cribbage season. The win came the hard way as his last match pitted him vs. Two-Star Harry Palmer (MA), perennial winner in the Eastern Region. With the 2nd place finish, Palmer has topped 500 MRP's for the year and is in the hunt once again. One-Star Phyllis Schmidt (MA) and Jim Tanner (VA) finished 3-4. Schmidt's 87 MRP's (aggregate) has her at the 500 mark, and she, too, is in the national hunt for honors (again). Schmidt also took Q honors with a nice 35 17/22 +146.

It was almost the Rick Allen Show in the Consolation as he qualified tops (18 8/10 +105) and came home 2nd in the playoffs as this Virginia player continues to smoke the boards. Another Virginia player won the playoffs...Ron Reece. Randy Skaradek (MD) and Master Jack Howsare (VA) finished 3-4. Howsare is the director of this event. Bill Robe (OR) and Grand Master Verne Nielsen (OR) finished 3-4.

Master David Gilkeson (OR) had a great run in the 80-player Consolation. He topped the field in the qualifying round, and finished 2nd in the playoffs. Only Shane Brook (OR) had his number in the final playoff match. Two-Star Duane Toll (WI) and Sue Edwards (CO) finished 3-4. Brook is a new ACC member who signed on just before play. He qualified 11th and came home the winner in the playoffs, getting off to a roaring start with the ACC.

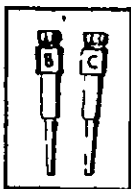
Buckley First Canadian Grand Master

Coincidence?? Lori Johnson (MN 1086) of Club 240 in Arden Hills, MN and Art Fisher (CA 624) of Club 82 in Seaside, CA each got a 28 hand on 9/18/02 and then a Grand Slam Scorecard the following week on 9/25/02!

November 25th was a good night for Club 54 in Pittsburg, CA. Stephen Reynolds (CA 1026) received a 28 hand and Evelyn Gillmore (CA 948) had a 20/9/+218 Grand Slam scorecard. Good things really do happen on the same day!

The River City Peggers (Club 162) in Sacramento, CA has inaugurated a Club Challenge. Their first competition took place on November 16th versus The Placer Peggers (Club 190) from Auburn, CA. At stake would be bragging rights for the year and a "beautiful" trophy for the victors. There were 12 players on each team, playing 14 games. After 7 games, the Auburn club had a generous lead: 107 game points to 73. It looked like trouble in River City. As in many tournaments, the lunch break proved fateful. The Sacramento club rallied, scoring 112 game points to Auburn's 72. Final Score: River City Peggers 185, Placer Peggers 179. 12 players and 14 games and only a net spread of plus 6? Amazing! This is quite an achievement for a club that has completed only six seasons. Stop by and check them out if you're in the area! Here's wishing all of them the best of luck in the 1/31/03 TOC.

Tim Morrissey, Living Legend of Club 45 in Chehalis-Centralia, WA by "Ras" Rasmussen. Tim scored 153 gamepoints and averaged 12.75 gamepoints weekly for twelve sessions of summer 2002. During that period Tim was the only repeat winner and he won three of the summer sessions. He shattered the net spread point record by nearly 200 points with 855. Tim also shattered the summer club skunk record and scored 14 skunk wins. That's just summer 2002. During four of the past five seasons, Tim was the only member of the Chehalis-Centralia Cribbage Club to win more than 60% of his games. During the 1997-1998 season Tim averaged 12.9 gamepoints weekly for 21 tournaments played and had a batting average for the season of .651. The 1998-99 season was a let-down for Tim. His gamepoint average plummeted to 12.3 for 26 tournaments with a batting average of .615. In the 1999-00 season, Tim had a .634 batting average and averaged 12.2 playing 24 of 36 tourneys. During the 2001-2002 season, Tim had a batting average of .642 and averaged 12.8 gamepoints per tournament played. He misses 10-20 sessions in each official season. If he had played a full 36 tourneys in any one of these five years and maintained his winning percentage, he would be unchallenged as National Grass Roots Cribbage Champion. He placed second in the Na-

tional Grass Roots tournament (GRNT) of 1999. Tim was first of 1,627 players in the GRNT in 2001. He has been in the top fifty of America three of the last five seasons even though missing 10-20 tournaments per season. Tim holds the record for highest gamepoint average for an official quarter of play with 14.7 gamepoints per tourney played in the 3rd quarter 1997-1998. Can anybody top that for twelve sessions of play? Tim earned 136 national rating points in a single quarter (12 nine-game cards). Hang on for another chapter soon!

Last month you read that two Club 62 members in Roseburg, OR had 28 hands in the same tournament. Well two weeks later that club has done it again! On November 19th Skip White ID 47 and Darlene Handy OR 3289 both got a 28 hand. Darlene had just applied for her ACC Membership and received her 28 hand before the number was processed. A very nice way for a new player to start with a club!

As this column grows and the number of submittals increase, I would like to request that you try to keep your articles to a maximum of about 100 words.

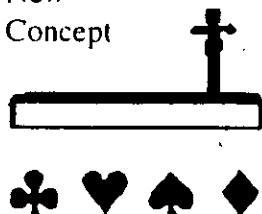

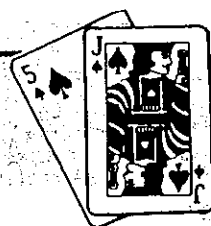
