## Directions

From West (Bay Area): I-80 to 50 East. Exit at Hazel, North 1.6 miles. Right on Kruitof.

From North: I-5 South to Sacramento, then 50 East. Exit at Hazel, North 1.6 miles. Right on Kruitof.

From South: I-5 North to Sacramento, then 50 East. Exit at Hazel, North 1.6 miles. Right on Kruitof.

From East: I-80 to Rocklin, exit at Sierra College. South on Sierra College. Sierra College becomes Hazel when it crosses into Sacramento County. Continue south on Hazel to Madison Ave (approx 10 miles from I-80). Continue south on Hazel 0.7 miles and turn left on Sunset Avenue. At the first Stop Sign turn Right into Phoenix Park. Make another Right as soon as you enter the Park (almost like making a "U" turn). Follow the park road around towards the VFW Hall. Make the first Right turn to exit Phoenix Park. The VFW Hall is on the Left.

## **ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL SIDE POOLS**

**TEAM PLAY.** Four (4) players each team, entry fee \$20.00 per team. One of the team members completes the entry ticket including the seat number for each team member. Must enter before play begins. Graduated payout to top 25%. Payout made after all score cards are completed and cross checking is completed.

**DOUBLE PLAY POOL:** \$20 entry fee must be paid prior to start of play in the RIVER CITY FALL CLASIC. Combined score of qualifying round from both tournaments. Graduated payout to the top 25%. Payout made after all score cards are completed and cross checking is completed.

**WINNER TAKE ALL POOL.** \$5.00 entry. Must enter before start of play. Entire pool is paid to the highest card, after cross checking is completed.
