NCD LONG MATCH DETAILS

1. In addition to what is listed here, the ACC Rules for Internet Play shall also be in effect.

2. All games must be played on eCribbage. Matches will be played in either of the two ACC rooms. Settings must be Best-of-7, Loser Deals.
3. Watching players matches is not allowed. You may view the progress of the match ONLY by being present in the ACC Room, however, entering the game is prohibited.
4. All players must be an ACC member in good standing with a registered eCribbage name. If new to eCribbage, create an account and register the name at: <https://accinternet29.wixsite.com/internetreg>
5. First round begins January 10th, 2021. See schedule below for timeframe to play each round. The number of players will determine which schedule to follow. **If you do not think that you can finish in the timeframe noted, or, do not think you can be flexible with scheduling games, please reconsider signing up.**
6. If you finish your round early and so has your next opponent, you may begin the next round early if both parties agree.
7. **It is up to BOTH players to get your games scheduled over the course of each round.** Please show each other the utmost courtesy and respect as you get those games scheduled. If you find yourself busy in your personal life, at least RESPOND to your opponent and let them know what is going on. Coordinate scheduling by using either Facebook Messenger (you do not have to be friends to message) or via email. I will let you know if you have an opponent that is not on Facebook and provide you with their email address.
8. Unfortunately, you WILL run across situations where it is difficult to schedule with someone. Handle them with dignity. Let Teri Murdy or James Morrow know of any problems. Remember, you are scheduling with opponents who may be in a different time zone. **You need to be flexible. If it is a week with 2 rounds that need to be played, try to schedule the first round as early in that week as possible to allow ample time to play the next round.**
9. You MUST report your win to either Teri (terimurdy@yahoo.com) or James (the29seeker@yahoo.com) either by email or Facebook Messenger.
10. Results will be shown on a Challenge bracket that will be pinned to the top of the Facebook page. For those without Facebook, please bookmark the bracket after it is emailed to you.
11. Player matchups will be randomly drawn. If we start with an odd number for the bracket, players will be randomly drawn for a bye.

If you have any questions, feel free to ask them. Teri and James will be more than happy to answer them. Thanks again for playing, and good luck to everyone!
